- **ADVANCE RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED FOR CAMPING!** Please call 530-626-5600 to reserve.
- **For our rafting guests, one night of complimentary camping (either before or after your trip) is available.** There is a fee of \$10.00/night/person for non-rafting guests. Additional nights may be reserved, pending availability of space, for a fee of \$10.00/night/person.
- **NO CAR CAMPING PERMITTED - ALL CAMPSITES ARE WALK-IN ONLY.** Hand carts are available for your convenience to help move your gear to your campsite. Please return them as soon as you're done.
- **Check-in is between 3:30 – 8 PM.** If you've reserved extra nights of camping and plan on arriving a day before your rafting trip, please check in at the O.A.R.S. American River Outpost store between 3:30 – 8 PM. At this time, a staff member will be available to assist you. If your schedule requires you to arrive after 8 PM or if you're running behind and can't avoid arriving late, prior arrangements must be made by calling our main office during regular business hours (8 AM – 6 PM). Our phone number is 530-626-5600.
- **If you're rafting on the day you are scheduled to depart our campground please clear your campsite prior to your trip meet time.** If you're not rafting on your day of departure, please pack up and empty your campsite by 11 AM. You're not required to leave the campground upon vacating your campsite—you may stay and enjoy activities in the camp or hang out down by the river.
- **Small (8' x 10') backpacker-type dome tents are recommended (No jumbo tents).** The smaller your tent, the more options you'll have on where to put it. While in camp, please consolidate your belongings so there's plenty of room for everyone.
- **Park in the main parking area.** Please do not block access to any storage containers.
- **Quiet time is between 9 PM and sunrise.** This is a family-friendly campground: appropriate behavior is expected.
- **This is a smoke-free campground.** Please limit smoking to the designated smoking area at the far end of the parking lot.
- **Campfires must only be built in the existing fire rings/pans.** Due to state fire restrictions, campfires and charcoal grills are not permitted after Memorial Day.
- **For your cooking needs, please bring your own gas stove or grill.** Charcoal grills and campfires are prohibited after Memorial Day.
- **Please leave our tables, chairs, benches, etc. where they are.**
- **Be gentle on our septic system.** Don't try to flush tampons or large amounts of toilet paper down the toilet. Please use the provided bins to dispose of trash.
- **Amplified music is not permitted in order to allow natural sounds to prevail.**
- **NO DOGS are allowed at our campground.** Please make other arrangements for your pets and accept our apologies with this policy.
- **RVs and trailers less than 50 feet long are welcome to be parked in our parking lot, with advance notice.** Hook-ups are not available. Generators are strictly prohibited. Ask us about local campgrounds.
- **Leave your valuables at home or lock them in your car during the day.** O.A.R.S. cannot be responsible for any damage to your car or anything taken from it. Car keys can be stored in our on-site office while you're on the river.
- **Tents, sleep kits and sleeping pads are available to rent.** Advance reservations required. Please call for prices. (A sleep kit includes a sleeping bag, sheet liner, camp pillow, sleeping pad and ground tarp.)
- **O.A.R.S. catered meals may be available for an additional charge.** Please call 530-626-5600 for details.
- **Flashlights and/or headlamps are a necessity.** Lighting is minimal.
